

Why did TFB change from .com to .BANK?

- Stronger verification of domain-name approval.
- Requires multifactor authentication for banks.
- .Bank is directed by banking and security experts.
- Stronger encryption standards for online communication between the institution and customer and within the institution itself.
- Reduces website-hijacking.
- Emails sent from a .BANK address help ensure that email messages received really are from the Bank.
